GCSE examination Synopsis Summer 2021

These results were Covid Teacher-Assessed grades submitted by teachers with evidence to support their submissions. There were 84 Year 11 GCSE submissions.

Percentage of Year 11 pupils gaining Grade 4 (Low C) or above was 82%

Percentage of Year 11 pupils gaining Grade 5 (high C) or above was 74%

Percentage gaining old A* - B was 51% (including ten Grade 9s, Thirteen Grades 8s, Eleven Grade 7s, Two Grade 6s)

In the 6th Form pupils also gained Grade 4s in Maths, English and Geography, Grade 6 in History, Grade 8 in DT and Grade 7 in Business Studies. Two pupils took higher qualifications with a successful Grade A pass in the level 3 EPQ qualification in ICT.

There were numerous other qualifications taken by Year 10 and above and passed at Level 1 and Level 2 plus merits and distinctions in the Cambridge National Sports Course. Many pupils obtained LAMDA qualifications and 6th Formers passed their Duke of Edinburgh Bronze award.

2019 was the last time that pupils sat examinations and is included for comparison.

Examination Results Synopsis Summer 2019

Year 11 GCSE Results

24% of grades achieved were 7-9 (A and A*), 40% were 5-9 (Upper C to A*), 58% were 4-9. (lower C to A*)

Six Grade 9s, nine Grade 8s and seven Grade 7s were awarded.

One pupil received eight Grade 6s and above. (five 8s, two 7s and one 6).

Three other pupils received five Grade 6s and above

Top grades were 9s in combined science and Maths, 8s in Computer Science, History and English, in addition to 7s in DT and Drama, and 6s in RE, Business Studies and Music.

One pupil received EPQ History (A higher Level 3 qualification) grade B
Geography, History, Combined Science and Art all had 100% at 4 or above.
