The successful candidate will be required to assess pupils across the age-range and plan and deliver individual therapy, write and deliver programmes in accordance with their needs and with support of OTAs. The pupils may present with DCD/Dyspraxia, Autistic Spectrum Conditions, physical/medical needs and sensory processing difficulties, ADHD as well as other diagnoses/difficulties and all combinations.

Previous experience of Educational Health and Care Plans including report writing attendance at Annual Reviews and setting and reviewing of short-term outcomes is an advantage as is an understanding and interest in Sensory Processing difficulties

You will join a friendly and cohesive integrated teaching and therapy team. To be considered for this role, you must be registered with the British Association of Occupational Therapists, have HCPC registration and have experience of working with similar services.
