9 = top 25% of the old A, 8 = remainder of A*, 7 = A, 6 = B, 5 = top C, 4 = lower C, 3 = D, 2 = E, 1 = F/G*

Government Requirement for no re-take of Maths and English is Grade 4

In year 11 the percentage of exam results at GCSE grade 4 or greater = 46%

The percentage of exam results at GCSE Grade 5 or greater = 28%

Pupils obtained grade 7-9 in maths, science, RE and history with 6s in English and Geography.

In the 6th Form pupils also gained GCSE Grade 4s and above in Maths, English, Art, Spanish and Business.

Three pupils took a higher level 3 qualification with successful passes in EPQ History of A*, A and C
